- No person, group, government or country is immune from biological terrorist attack
- The <u>threat</u> of biological terrorist attack induces great fear in population
- Poor man's weapon
- Great deal of technical information available to public

#### NCIS Europe

- Biological warfare agents with terrorist use potential
  - -Anthrax
  - Plague
  - Smallpox



- Weaponization of Biological Agents
  - Agent Selection
    - **◆**Toxicity
    - Availability
    - **◆**Infectiousness
    - **◆**Ease of production capabilities



- Agent Acquisition
  - **◆**Purchase
    - -Many hazardous substances commercially available
    - -World Directory of Collections of Cultures of Microorganisms
  - Occur naturally in environment



- **◆**Theft
  - **Large stockpiles worldwide**
- Obtain from government
  - -30 countries have mature chemical and biological weapons programs



- Agent Production
  - **◆**Too much information on internet
  - ◆Amount of technical knowledge ranges from low to high, depending on agent
    - -Aum Shinrikyo sarin agent attack in Tokyo subway in 1995



- **Agent Delivery** 
  - Considered more difficult for terrorists than production
  - Aerosol containers
    - -Air sprayer
      - Crowd control device
    - -Agricultural pesticide sprayers



- Projectiles
  - -Munitions
    - IED or dirty bomb
  - -Umbrella attack
    - 1978 attempted assassination of Bulgarian defectors, toxin ricin



- **◆Inanimate object** 
  - -Book
- Meteorological conditions at target
  - **◆**Temperature
  - Wind
  - **♦**Rain



- Results of Bioterrorism
  - Death or injury
  - -Fear
  - Expenditure of personnel
    - **◆**Medical
    - **◆**Law enforcement
    - **◆Intelligence**



- Loss of resources
  - **◆**Personnel
    - -Killed or injured
    - -Medical
      - 1995 Ebola outbreak in Zaire,
        92% fatality rate, most were
        health care workers



- **◆Buildings** 
  - -Office where attack occurred
  - -Hospital where patients went for treatment
- **◆Food and water supply** 
  - -Foot and mouth disease
  - -February 2002 attempt to poison water supply near U.S. Embassy

NCIS Europe

- **◆**Money
  - -U.S Congress appropriated \$1,000,000,000 for bioterrorism preparedness



- Pre-Attack Activity--Prevention
  - Contact with legitimate suppliers
    - Who is trying to acquire agents, delivery and production systems?
  - Is collection violation of law?



- Coordination among intelligence, law enforcement, medical and governmental agencies
- -Know what to look for
  - Aum Shinrikyo production labs
- Searches, arrests



- During Attack
  - If disease, is outbreak criminal?
    - Work with medical investigators
  - Collect evidence
    - **♦**Who
      - -Special Handling
      - -Training

- Governments are not prepared for a large scale bioterrorist attack
- Lack of preparedness will add to confusion and fear
