Damià Barceló is Honorary Adjunct Professor at the University of Almeria, Spain, and retired Full Research Professor at IDAEA-CSIC, Barcelona. He holds several honorary titles and has received numerous international awards for his work on emerging contaminants and environmental chemistry. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Chemistry and member of the Académie Nationale de Pharmacie. With an H-index of 155 and over 1700 publications, he ranks among the world's top scientists. Prof. Barceló has served as Co-Editor-in-Chief and Editor for multiple Elsevier journals since 1990, including Science of the Total Environment (STOTEN), Green Analytical Chemistry (GREEAC), Methods X, Current Opinion in Environmental Science & Health (COESH), and Current Opinion in Solid State & Materials Science (CSCEE). He is Editor-in-Chief of the Wilson & Wilson Comprehensive Analytical Chemistry book series (Elsevier) since 1997. He is also Co-Editor-in-Chief of the Handbook of Environmental Chemistry (Springer, since 2007) and the book series Advances in Chemical Pollution, Environmental Management and Protection (Elsevier, since 2016). Since 1993, he has edited or co-edited more than 40 books on environmental chemistry.
