# **The Rector**

**Considering** articles 1, paragraph 4, and 2, paragraph 4 of the University Statute;

**Considering** article 5, paragraph 1, of the University Statute by which the University ensures "freedom and autonomy [...] in organising and carrying out research and training activities [...] with respect for the principles of freedom and human dignity, peaceful coexistence among peoples";

**Considering** the exceptional difficulties Ukrainian students are experiencing as a result of the current emergency situation in Ukraine;

**Considering** note no. 1/2023, internal protocol no. 29293 dated 27.01.2023 of the National Erasmus+ INDIRE Agency, titled "Emergency in Ukraine – Erasmus+ Program Higher Education Sector – Further instructions on managing student and staff mobility – KA131 Action Call 2022";

**Considering** the opportunity of exceptionally amending the Agreement mentioned in the Object in order to introduce the incoming mobility flow for students and staff from Ukraine;

**Considering** the National Erasmus+ INDIRE Agency's opinion, internal protocol no. 24652 dated 25.01.2023, which specified that the requirement making the incoming student mobility action possible is the participant's status as a registered student belonging to a Ukrainian educational institution who had to leave Ukraine due to the ongoing war. Therefore, nationality is not relevant to make such participants, already present in our country or still in Ukraine, eligible for support through Erasmus+;

**Having deemed appropriate** to make resources available for the reception of students through a call for incoming mobility grants for students from Ukrainian universities, already in our country or still in Ukraine;

Having, also, deemed appropriate to allow students who are already carrying out a period of mobility under the Call for incoming mobility grants for students, teachers and researchers from Ukrainian universities and research institutions (issued by DR no. 959 of 22.04. 2022), to be able to continue the second semester at the University of Perugia, by submitting an application under this current call and to be able to continue to use the services related to accommodation and board at the Umbria Agency for the Right to University Studies (ADISU), upon sending to ADISU a copy of the application for participation to this call;



**Considering** that this call is published pending the conclusion of the amendment to Agreement No. 2022-1-IT02-KA131-HED-000056188 for the introduction of the incoming student mobility flow from Ukraine;

CALL FOR INCOMING MOBILITY GRANTS FOR STUDENTS FROM UKRAINIAN UNIVERSITIES - ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME KEY ACTION 1 (KA1) - CALL 2022 - PROJECT NO. 2022-1-IT02-KA131-HED-000056188

### Art. 1 – Object, amount and duration of mobility grants

In order to further support students enrolled in Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree courses, Level I and II Master's degrees, specialisation schools and doctorates, coming from Ukrainian Universities, it is possible to finance, on an exceptional basis, within the Erasmus+KA131 mobility projects, the incoming mobility of students enrolled at a Ukrainian Higher Education Institution, fleeing from Ukraine due to the recent war conflict, who intend to carry out mobility.

The mobility activities must take place at the University of Perugia and must end by 31 May 2024.

# **Art. 2 - Individual support and travel contributions**

Individual contributions for incoming mobility of students enrolled in Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree courses, Level I and II Master's degrees, specialisation schools and doctorates, coming from Ukrainian universities will be recognised only for the period of study/internship carried out at the University of Perugia through the allocation of mobility grants, the amount of which is defined as follows:

A first payment equal to 80% of the EU contribution is disbursed within 30 calendar days after signature of the Agreement by both parties.

The balance of the EU contribution is paid at the end of the mobility, after the online submission of the Narrative Report (EU SURVEY).

# Art. 3 - Eligibility requirements for selection

Students enrolled in Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree courses, Level I and II Master's degrees, specialisation schools and doctorates, at a Ukrainian higher education institution at the time of their flight from Ukraine due to Russian aggression, may apply for the allocation of grants under this call, for study or internship mobility.

In order to participate, Ukrainian students must be in possession of at least one of the following documents: certificate of enrolment, declarations issued by higher education institutions or competent Ukrainian authorities.

# Art. 4 - Submission of application

The application must be submitted **by 1 pm on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> of February 2023** exclusively by sending the documents below via e-mail to the following address:

<u>office.relint+ucraina@unipg.it</u>, specifying the following subject: 'Call for applications Erasmus+ Ukraine'.

Applicants must submit, under penalty of exclusion, the following documents:

- 1. the **application form**, duly completed in accordance with the model annexed to this Call, which forms an integral part of this call;
- 2. copy of a valid identity document;
- 3. **certificate** issued by the home university, or statement issued by higher education institutions or competent Ukrainian authorities, documenting enrolment in a course of study at a Ukrainian university;
- 4. **Learning Agreement** of the educational activities that the student intends to carry out at the University of Perugia (annexed to the present Call). As provided by the above-mentioned note no. 1/2023, prot. no. 612/2023 of 11.01.2023, of the Erasmus+ National Agency INDIRE, when submitting the application, the Learning Agreement may be signed by the participant and, after the selection of participants, also by the host



institution only if the signature of the sending or home institution is not available.

All documents submitted must be in English or Italian.

This notice of this call will be published on the University of Perugia's online notice board <a href="https://www.unipg.it/albo-ufficiale">https://www.unipg.it/albo-ufficiale</a> and will also be available at the following website: <a href="https://www.unipg.it/internazionale">https://www.unipg.it/internazionale</a>.

#### Art. 5 - Selection

The evaluation of applications will be carried out by a special Commission appointed by Rectoral Decree.

The selection will take into account the Learning Agreement submitted. Priority will be given to students who are already carrying out a period of mobility within the framework of the Call for the provision of incoming mobility grants for students, teachers and researchers from Ukrainian universities and research institutions (issued by DR no. 959 of 22.04.2022). The list of candidates who are beneficiaries of the grants and of those who are eligible will be published on the University of Perugia's online notice board <a href="https://www.unipg.it/albo-ufficiale">https://www.unipg.it/albo-ufficiale</a> and will also be available for consultation at: <a href="https://www.unipg.it/internazionale">https://www.unipg.it/internazionale</a>.

Beneficiaries will receive notification of the allocation of the mobility grant by e-mail.

# Art. 6 - Acceptance/rejection of mobility

Within the peremptory term of 7 days from the date of receipt of the notification of the allocation of the mobility grant, the beneficiary shall send, by e-mail to the address <u>ufficio.relint+ucraina@unipg.it</u>, the declaration of acceptance or renunciation of the mobility grant "Erasmus+Ukraine call". The acceptance of the mobility grant is made under the conditions set out in this call without reservation, under penalty of forfeiture. With the declaration of acceptance the grantee of the mobility grant undertakes, under its own responsibility, to communicate any changes that may occur during the period of the mobility grant with respect to what has previously been declared.

Payment of the contribution will be made by bank transfer to a current account in the name of or co-owned by the beneficiary student.

Art. 7 - ADISU benefits



Students awarded incoming mobility grants enrolled at the University of Perugia, in order to be able to benefit from services related to accommodation and board, may apply to the Umbria Right to University studies Agency (Agenzia per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario dell'Umbria - ADISU).

Students who are already carrying out a period of mobility under the Call for the provision of incoming mobility grants for students, teachers and researchers from Ukrainian universities and research institutions (issued with DR no. 959 of 22.04.2022) and, for this reason, beneficiaries of ADISU measures provided for by Decree no. 3/2022 expiring on 4<sup>th</sup> of February 2023 (https://www.adisu.umbria.it/altri-benefici-concorso/avviso/2022-2023/interventi-straordinari-favore-di-studenti-universitari), will receive automatic confirmation of the benefits granted upon submission of an application for participation to this call. To this end, a copy of the application must be sent promptly to ADISU at the e-mail address emergenzaguerra@adisu.umbria.it.

In accordance with articles 5 and 6 ADISU will verify, at the Università degli Studi di Perugia, the positive outcome of the investigation on those applications whose board and lodging benefits have been extended.
