PhD Program in Consumer Law

The PhD programme aims to train lawyers with an international profile that is now necessary to deal with the new transboundary dynamics of consumer relationships. For this reason, the PhD course offers a double degree programme in collaboration with the Faculty of Law, University of Salamanca. At the end of the PhD programme, the PhD student will receive two PhD diplomas, one from the University of Perugia (Italy) and the other one from the University of Salamanca (Spain). The PhD school maintains close cooperation with the University of Salamanca (Spain), University of Valencia (Spain), the University of Coimbra (Portugal) and the University of the Republic of Uruguay - Montevideo (Uruguay).

The PhD student will have to participate, at least for 12 months, in an international exchange programme. Attendance in a foreign university for this period of time is mandatory. The internationality that characterises the PhD programme puts a particular emphasis on languages. The PhD programme in "Consumer Law" has a duration of three years. During this time, the PhD students are required to attend, in addition to the institutional courses organised by the University of Perugia, a large number of seminars and conferences with Italian and International experts.
