The Rector

Considering art. 4 of Law 3.7.1998, no.210;

Considering Law 30.12.2010, no.240 on "Norms relating to the organization of the universities, of employment procedures, along with mandate to the Government to enhance the quality and the efficiency of the university system";

Considering University Statute issued by Decree no.889 on 28.5.2012;

Considering the General Regulations of the University, issued by Decree no.470 on 29.3.2013;

Considering Decree 28.12.2000, no.445 and subsequent modifications and integrations;

Considering Law 12.11.2011, no.183 in particular art. 15;

Considering the decree by the Minister of Education, University and Research (MIUR) "Regulations concerning the modality of accreditation of institutions and doctoral programs and criteria for establishing doctoral programs by accredited institutions", no.45 on 8.2.2013;

Considering MIUR annotation protocol no.12053 on 22.5.2013, which establishes guidelines to implement research doctorates for the academic year 2013/2014 based on Ministerial Decree 8.2.2013, no.45;

Considering the Regulation of Research Doctorate of the University of Perugia, issued by Rectoral Decree no.1548 on 7.8.2013;

Considering annotation protocol no.2891 on 6.12.2012, with which MIUR has allocated University funds for seventeen scholarships for three-year research doctoral programs, to be funded with the resources for young researchers considered for the 2012 financial cycle;

Considering deliberation of the Academic Senate on 25.9.2013, which granted the establishment and implementation of research doctorate programs XXIX cycle – academic year 2013/2014;

Considering the deliberation of the Administration Council on 26.9.2013, which approved the proposals to establish and implement research doctoral programs for the academic year 2013/2014 (XXIX cycle);

Considering the deliberation of the Administration Council on 21.10.2013, which approved the budget to fund six scholarships for each doctoral program and approved the issuance of the related call for applicants;

Considering Rectoral Decree no.1985 on 31.10.2013, which established the allocation of the seventeen doctoral scholarships to be funded with the budget of young researchers among the doctoral programs activated for the XXIX cycle and which will be approved by the appointed authorities during the earliest convenient session;

Considering Rectoral Decree no. 1996 on 6.11.2013, which established the financial requirements for applying and attending courses during the academic year 2013/2014, to be approved by the appointed authorities entities at the earliest convenient session;

Considering the notes of Course Coordinators of the research doctoral programs, activated for the XXIX cycle, relating to the necessary guidelines for the issuance of the call for applicants;

Considering Rectoral Decree no.1997 on 6.11.2013, activating courses of research doctoral programs – XXIX cycle – herein reported, with administrative venue at the University of Perugia– academic year 2013/2014, to be approved by authorizing entities during the earliest convenient session;

DECREES

Art.1

Issuance

A public selection is issued for admission to Research Doctoral programs of the XXIX cycle for the academic year 2013/2014, with legal address at the University of Perugia (see Annex 1, which constitutes an integral part of this Call). Admission to the Research Doctoral programs is granted through application procedures in accordance with art.15 of the Regulation of Research Doctoral Programs of this University, issued by Rectoral Decree no.1548 of 7.8.2013 and specified, for each doctoral program, in the aforementioned Annex, within which the following are specified: duration, number of available positions, number of available scholarships, number of available positions without scholarship, possible reserved positions, possible organizational structure in curricula, possible candidates subjected to a different economic agreement, the Coordinator, the required admission Degrees, the procedures applied for the selection and the timeline of examinations.

The number of scholarships, indicated for each doctoral program in Annex 1 to this Call, can be increased pending additional funding. The possible additional scholarships will be determined with a Rectoral Decree, before examinations are held and posted on the University online bulletin board.

Art.2

Admission requirements

To be able to apply for selection procedures specified in the previous article, candidates, regardless of their citizenship must have, by the expiration date of the present Call either a master's degree ('Laurea Magistrale'), obtained in accordance with Ministerial Decree 270/2004, a master's degree ('Laurea specialistica') obtained in accordance with Ministerial Decree 509/1999 or a University Diploma ('Laurea Vecchio Ordinamento') obtained in accordance with regulations in place before the Ministerial Decree 509/1999, from an Italian University, **in compliance with the indications, for each doctoral program reported in Annex 1 to the present Call pertaining the required degrees for admission**, or, for those who have an equivalent academic qualification pursued abroad and declared equivalent, with motivated and documented deliberation by the examining Commission of the selection as requested by the candidate, and submitted along with the application to participate in the admissions selection and the appropriate documentation. Equivalence with the foreign qualification, which is valid for the sole purpose of the admission selection, is admitted in compliance with the specific regulating

norms in Italy and in the countries where the qualification was issued and according to the treaties or international agreements for the acknowledgement of academic degrees. Candidates with foreign academic qualifications must submit the following documents along with their application: degree, original copy or authenticated copy, along with official translation in Italian, notarized (when necessary) and corresponding declaration of value issued by the Diplomatic Representative or Italian Consulate in the country where the degree was awarded.

Candidates must fill out the application forms with all the information required in Attached forms A and A1 (the latter only in case of equivalences), which are to be considered integral parts of the herein Call for applicants.

All candidates are admitted with reservation to the selection until background checks, as required in the Call, are completed. The Administration has the authority to exclude any candidate from the selection procedure at any time. Furthermore, the administration will automatically verify the legitimacy of the candidates' substitute certification statements.

The efficacy of the selection presented herein is contingent upon the final approval by the appointed authorities of this University of aforementioned Rectoral Decrees no. 1985 of 31.10.2013, no. 1996 of 6.11.2013 and no.1997 of 6.11.2013 mentioned in the premises.

Art.3

Admission application

The admission applications, compiled in replacement of an issued statement or notarized certificate, in accordance with art. 46 and 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000, as in (Annex A – Annex A1 in case of equivalence application), duly compiled and signed (mandatory requirements for admission) including all the required documentation **must be sent to** the Magnifico Rettore of the University of Perugia - Piazza dell'Università n.1 – 06123 – Perugia and must arrive before the deadline of **4 December 2013 - at 13.00 (Italian time)**.

The following methods for submittal are allowed::

- directly at the front desk of the Reception at the Central Offices (Palazzo Murena) – P.zza Università, 1 – Perugia – during its opening days and hours;
- registered mail with return signature to the Rector of the University at the aforementioned address; applications received after the deadline will not be accepted even if posted before the deadline. On the envelope containing the application and documents the following should be written: "**Domanda di ammissione al corso di dottorato di ricerca in dell'Università degli Studi di Perugia – XXIX CICLO**", ("**Application to the research doctoral program in..... of the university of Perugia – XXIX Cycle**") along with the sender's address;
- email with certified mail to the PEC address protocollo@cert.unipg.it, of Annex A (and of Annex A1 in case of equivalence request)– along with a photocopy of an identity document - properly filled as follows, signed and scanned and saved as PDF, that is signed digitally, along with pertinent documentation and signed where required and then scanned and saved as PDF, or signed with electronic signature; any documentation received from a non-certified electronic address or sent to another email address of the university; analogously, documents



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sent in formats other than Pdf will not be accepted; in the subject line of the email the following should be written: "**D.R. n. del domanda di ammissione al corso di dottorato di ricerca inXXIX ciclo**". ("Rectoral Decree no..... of Application for admission to the research doctoral program in XXIX Cycle") (N.B. in order to avoid transmission issues, the following is advised: the application should be sent in one single email, any Pdf file should be scanned in black and white and with low resolution, the total size of the email should not exceed 5 MB);
- submission of the application and the relative documentation properly compiled as mentioned below by fax at 075/5852067 - 075/5852267.

Please be advised that in order to be accepted, all applications must be received by the deadline of 4.12.2013 - at 13.00 hrs (Italian time) and the postal stamp will be proof and evidence of arrival at the Protocol Office of the University. Therefore, applications and relative documentation received after the deadline, will not be considered, even if posted beforehand.

Candidates with foreign degrees who do not submit the required documentation along with the application, in accordance with art. 2 to verify the equivalence of the qualification, will be admitted with reservation and even if selected, will not be admitted to enrollment due to lack of documentation, if this documentation is not submitted in time to allow background verification to be completed in time.

The application must be signed without notarization in front of the appointed clerk at the moment of submission or signed and presented along with a photocopy of a form of identification to avoid exclusion. If the form of identification has expired, the candidate will, in accordance with art. 45 of D.P.R. 445/2000, declare on the photocopy that the information on the ID card has not changed since its issuance.

In the application the candidate applying for participation to the selection procedures must declare under his/her own responsibility and in accordance with articles 46 and 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000:

1. His/her name date and place of birth, residence and mailing address for the Call (specifying the zip code) and, if possible, telephone number, fax number, and email address; candidates are obliged to communicate any changes to this information. For foreign candidates within and outside of the European Community, an Italian address or that of their Embassy in Italy is required;
2. the name of the exact name of the doctoral program for which the candidate is applying;
3. his/her citizenship;
4. fluency in the Italian language (only for foreign EU or not EU);
5. the degree awarded, required in accordance with art.2 of this Call and specified in detail in Annex 1, along with the date of award and the name of the awarding University and the final mark, or the degree for which the equivalence is being requested, if awarded at a foreign university;
6. the foreign language which will be tested during the oral examination (applicable only for those who apply for doctoral programs for which it is possible to choose among several foreign languages);



7. specification whether oral examination should be conducted in videoconference and identification of a valid contact address for this purpose (only for doctoral programs for which this is possible);
8. whether the candidate is/isn't the recipient of a foreign scholarship (only for the doctorate PhD courses for which there are reserved places);
9. only for the disabled: equipment or aid needed, and whether additional time is deemed to be needed to complete the examination in accordance with Law 05/02/1992, no.104 (a medical certificate in original or notarized copy stating the nature of the disability which authorizes the additional benefits, must be submitted along with the application. Lacking the aforementioned documentation the requested benefits cannot be allowed).
10. To authorize, in case the Administration receives motivated request to access official documents relating to the procedure and the candidate is the person against whom this request is made, the submission, via electronic email to the email address specified in the application, in accordance with art. 3 of the D.P.R. 184/2006, of the copy of the request with which access to the archives is performed and the possibility to challenge, with a rightful motivation, this request, also via electronic email, within ten days after receiving the request.
11. To accept all terms in this Call.

(N.B.) In order to properly fill out the application and to submit the required documents for admission to the present competition and also to evaluate the qualifications, all substitute Certification statements , in accordance with art. 46 of D.P.R. 445/2000 (with which personal status/data and listed facts according to art. 46 can be declared) and replacement declarations of notarized acts in accordance with art. 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000 (with which personal status/data and facts that the candidates are aware of can be declared and the compliance of a the photocopy of the original of a document, a publication, an academic degree, or a service certificate to the original) can be validly submitted in accordance with art. 3 of D.P.R. 445/2000, by Italian citizens and by citizens of the European Union; the citizens of Countries outside of the European Union legally residing in Italy can use replacement declarations in accordance with articles. 46 and 47 limitedly to the countries, the personal features and the certifiable (or verifiable by Italian public officials) facts, provided that the laws or regulations regarding immigration and the condition of the foreigner do not state otherwise and also that the use of these replacement declarations be authorized through international agreements between Italy and the country of origin and within the limits of these conditions.

The replacement declarations of certifications and notarized acts are considered submitted if they are subscribed by the candidate in front of the appointed clerk, or if they are subscribed and presented along with a photocopy of the candidate's form of identification, in accordance with art. 38, 3° comma, of D.P.R. 445/2000 to be valid and effective (a scheme of these declarations is attached: Annex B).

The Administration is obliged to perform checks (also randomly) and in all doubtful cases regarding the truthfulness of all replacement declarations as per articles. 46 and 47 of D.P.R. no. 445/2000. If checks reveal untruthfulness of the contents in the declaration, the candidate will lose any benefits accrued on the bases of these declarations in accordance with art. 75 of D.P.R. 445/2000,



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under conditions in art. 76 of the same D.P.R.

All applications should include (N.B. in accordance with art.15 of Law 183/2011, Public Administrations cannot accept certificates issued by other Public Administrations):

- photocopy of an identity document.
- **Receipt of payment of € 60,00 made** using the appropriate form (one for each doctoral program) downloadable at www.unipg.it/studenti under **"Dopo la laurea" - "Dottorati di ricerca" ("After your degree" - "Research Doctorates")**. Candidates who are abroad and cannot use the abovementioned form to make the payment, may send a bank transfer for that amount to the Università degli Studi di Perugia at UNICREDIT S.P.A. - Agenzia di Perugia Università -
IBAN IT70J0200803043000029407189 -BIC SWIFT UNCRITM1J11; please specify as follows: " Application for admissions selection to the doctoral program in at the University of Perugia XXIX cycle -2013/2014";
This sum will not be reimbursed under any circumstance whatsoever.

• Degrees as follows:

- For those who were awarded a degree in Italy:

The actual title, in original or authenticated copy, or copy which has been declared equal to the original by filling in Annex B, in accordance with articles 19 and 47 as per D.P.R. 445/2000, that is self-certified by means of a substitute certification statement, using Annex B in accordance with art. 46, D.P.R. 445/2000, which certifies the degree awarded, required in accordance with art.2 of this Call and detailed in Annex 1 as requisite for admission along with date the degree was awarded, the awarding University and the final mark (for those who have been awarded a degree from the University of Perugia, this documentation can be directly downloaded from the students' portal by logging into the private area);

- for those candidates who have a foreign degree: the title in original or authenticated copy, complete with the official translation in Italian legally certified (where necessary) and relative declaration of value issued by the Italian Consulate or Diplomatic Representation in the country where the degree was awarded along with documentation which is necessary for the jury Commission to ascertain the equivalences (see **N.B.**).

• The degrees and other titles to be evaluated and considered for in admissions application (see Annex 1 of this Call), must be presented as follows to avoid exclusion:

a)- original or authenticated copy;

b)- (limited to the subjects authorized to do so, see N.B.) copy declared equal to original, in accordance with art. 19 as per D.P.R. no. 445/2000, by means of a certification statement of the notarized certificate as per art. 47 of the D.P.R. no. 445/2000, by using Annex B;

c)- (limited to the subjects authorized to do so, see N.B.) self-certification of degrees, by means of replacement declaration or notarized act, in accordance with articles 46 and 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000, using Annex B. (**N.B.:** in case the candidate intends to self-certify using a Curriculum Vitae, the latter must be completed with a replacement certificate or notarized act in accordance with articles 46 and 47 of D.P.R. 445/2000, using Annex B, in which he/she declares that "the Curriculum Vitae states only factual content").

The modality for submittal as specified in c) cannot be used for certain titles (e.g. dissertations and publications) which need to be read in order to be evaluated, and therefore must be sent by using the modalities specified in a) and b);

d)- for degrees or titles in a language other than Italian, French, English, German or Spanish, an Italian translation must be submitted and certified by a diplomatic representative or consulate to be equal to the foreign document, or by in official translation or, where this is permitted (see N.B.), translated by the candidate and declared to be equal to the original document by using a substitute certification statement, in accordance with art. 47 of D.P.R. no. 445/2000, using Annex B.

Publications can be submitted for evaluation (including printed excerpts), provided they are submitted by following the instructions in this document.

Publications, printed in Italy before 2.9.2006 (when Regulations as per D.P.R. no. 252/2006 were put in place), must have been done by following instructions as per Decree "Luogotenenziale" no. 660/1945; if printed in Italy after this date, the legal deposit must have been duly performed as per D.P.R. no. 252 on 3.5.2006.

References cannot be made to documents or publications presented to this or other administrations or to documents attached to other applications for other competitions.

Applications and documentations which - albeit foreseen in this Call - are not submitted by using the conditions specified in this call will not be considered.

The Administration cannot be held liable in case contact is not possible between the parties (whether for the impossibility to reach the candidate, wrong address, failure on the candidate's part to timely inform this university of any changes in his/her address or contact information). Furthermore, the Administration will not be held liable in case communications are impeded due to postal or technical hurdles, a third party, a fortuitous occurrence or circumstances beyond one's control.

If the candidate wishes to apply for more than one doctoral program, he/she must submit an application for each and submit the necessary documentation. Please be advised that it may not be possible to participate in each selection due to the fact that examination dates may overlap. Should this be the case, the payment made will NOT be reimbursed in any case.

Art.4

Evaluation procedures

To guarantee a complete evaluation of each applicant, the selection procedure will be administered according to the guidelines in art.15 of the Regulation of Research Doctoral programs of this University, and specifically, for each doctoral program, according to the indications presented in Annex 1 of this Call.

A)-For Doctoral Programs in Annex 1 where degrees and oral examinations are foreseen:



- the Commission, in an initial meeting, will identify and report the criteria and marking system for qualifications and interview;
- Qualifications will be evaluated by the Commission before the interview;
- the candidate will receive a passing mark for the interview only if the mark is equal or above the minimum acceptable score which has been identified for each doctoral program and reported in Annex 1 of this Call;
- each candidate will receive the score on their qualifications before the interview;
- after each interview session, the Commission will post the scores outside the room where the interview took place so that candidates can view them;
- once all interviews have taken place, the Commission will rank candidates on the bases of merit by summing the scores of the qualifications and the interview. Passing scores will be considered if above the minimum acceptable cut score identified for each doctoral program in Annex 1 of this Call.

B)-For Doctoral programs in Annex 1 which foresee the evaluation of qualifications, written examinations and interviews:

- the Commission initially identifies and reports the criteria and marking scheme of qualifications, the written and the interview;
- the commission will evaluate qualifications before the written examination;
- the commission will report the marks of the written examination and post them outside the venue of the interviews and before the latter begin. Candidates who have received a passing mark (as identified in Annex 1 of this Call) on their written examination will be admitted to the interview;
- the passing mark on the interview must be equal or above the minimum score, as identified for each doctoral program in annex 1 of this call;
- each candidate will be notified as to the score on his/her qualifications before the beginning of the interview;
- at the end of each session of the interview, the Commission will post the scores outside the venue of the interview so candidates can view them;
- once the interview is over, the Commission will rank the candidates by summing the scores of their written examination, their interview and their qualifications. Candidates will pass the selection if their overall evaluation is equal or above the minimum acceptable score for each doctoral program in Annex 1 of this Call.

The schedule of the examinations for each doctoral program is reported in Annex 1 of this call. The aforementioned schedule is to be considered as a formal convocation. No private communications on this matter will be sent to the candidates.

On **December 6, 2013** an announcement will be published on the University webpage (www.unipg.it/studenti under "Dopo la laurea" - "Dottorati di ricerca" – and on the University online billboard either confirming or changing the venue, the dates and/or time of meetings, or any other communication deemed necessary.

Failure to show on the day, time and place of the examination will entail expulsion from the selection, regardless of the motivation.

To be allowed to sit the examination, candidates must have one of the following forms of identity: identity card (with picture), passport, driver's license, nautical license, pension document, thermal management system operating license, weapon license, ID cards provided they have a photograph and a seal or other equivalent stamp, issued by a governmental administration.



The above documents shall not have expired.

If a candidate has proof of identity which has expired, the form of ID must anyhow be exhibited and the candidate shall sign a photocopy of it which states that the information in the ID has not changed since the date of issuance.

Once the admission procedures have been completed, the acts and records will be either approved with a managerial provision or sent back to the Commission in order to regularize and/or integrate them. Candidates are admitted to the program if they are ranked accordingly with the terms of art.6. After approval, the lists with rankings will be posted at www.unipg.it/studenti under "**Dopo la laurea**" - "**Dottorati di ricerca**" and on the University public online billboard (**no private communications on this matter will be sent to the candidates**).

Candidates will have access to all formal acts accordingly with Law n.241/1990 and with the University Regulation regarding administrative procedures and access rights. The Administration can postpone access rights till after the selection is complete.

The results of the selection procedures in this decree are subordinate to the approval of the DD.RR. no. 1985 on 31.10.2013, no. 1996 on 6.11.2013 and no.1997 of 6.11.2013, mentioned in the premise by the authorizing entities of this University.

Art.5

Commissions

Commissions for admissions selection to research doctorates will be formed and appointed in compliance with art. 17 of the Regulation of the Research Doctorate Programs of this University.

The Commissions must complete their evaluation by the thirtieth day after the beginning of the first examination.

Art.6

Admission to courses

Candidates are admitted to courses accordingly to how they ranked on the merit list, up to the maximum number of positions available for each doctoral program. In case of a draw, the younger candidate will be selected.

In case a candidate is eligible in more than one list, at the moment of enrolment, the candidate must opt for one doctoral program only.

In case the candidate has applied for more than one doctoral program structured in curricula, at the time of enrolment must opt for one only.

The Administration will then proceed to collect all matriculation documents required to formally enrol those who are eligible according to how they ranked on the merit list.

In accordance with the decree activating the research doctorate programs-XXIX cycle - as per the present Call, the candidate admitted to the program must submit the documents to the 'Ufficio Scuole di dottorato e Assegni di ricerca' (Office of the School of research Doctorate and Research') by **31 December 2013 (no private communications on this matter will be sent to the candidates)**, or by the date of reception of the communication sent by the 'Ufficio Scuole di dottorato e Assegni di ricerca' in case of ranks changes. The relative forms are available at <http://www.unipg.it/ateneo/modulistica#a-dottorandi>.



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In case a candidate renounces or enrolment is not made before program inception, the following candidate in line will become eligible. Beyond this date, and in any case not after February 28th, 2014, this admission will be contingent to the decision of the Board of Teachers of the Doctorate Program Committee.

In order to complete the procedures of Admissions and following the official appointment of the scholarships, previously approved by the Board of Teachers of the Doctoral Program Committee, to those deemed eligible, the aforementioned scholarships will be made official by Managerial Decree and the list of candidates will be approved, including those as per Comma 2, lett. G of art.16 of the Regulation of the Doctorate Program of the University of Perugia.

Art.7 Scholarships

In accordance with the decree activating the research doctoral programs- XXIX cycle - as per the present Call, scholarships awarded in order to attend the Research Doctorate programs are annual and can be renewed for the second and the third year provided that the graduate student has completed the requirements for the previous year, and this is verified accordingly with the procedures established by the Regulations of the Program, and provided that the scholarship is assigned after having verified that the previous year requirements have been met.

For cycle XXIX, in order to establish scholarships to be funded with resources from the budget of one or more Departments, the Department Boards officially resolve to fund the three-year scholarships, thereby including the resources needed to finance the two-year research activity and, at the same time, or anyhow before the decree increasing the number of scholarships, they remit the entire sum to the central Administration in a single payment.

In order to establish scholarships which are funded by external resources, the agreement must include the transfer of all funds for the three-year program to the University in a single payment. These funds must include the two-year funding for research activity. In the agreement, the external entity agrees to reimburse the University, as a final balance refund, the additional funds for costs covering research work abroad. The university can decide that the entire scholarship cost, which has to be covered by the external entity, is to be paid in three instalments, one per year to be deposited no later than December 31 of each year antecedent the activity for which it is funded given that an adequate bank guaranty is provided.

The amount of the scholarship will be rendered monthly and is determined according to the Ministerial Decree of 18 June 2008 and subsequent modifications and integrations.

The amount of the scholarships is increased to a maximum of 50% on the total number and accordingly with the budget both for those funded by the Central Administration and for those of the single departments, for professional development abroad pending authorization from the Board of teachers, for periods under 18 months. This increase is granted only after having completed the aforementioned period of research activity abroad and upon submittal of a statement issued by the hosting agency director. The time interval of stay must be specified in the statement. In those cases where the period of time spent abroad is longer than two months, the increment can be provided in monthly payments during the period abroad and upon the graduate student's request along with a statement on behalf of the director of the organization hosting the student.



From the second year, each graduate student is awarded extra funds for research (limited to the approved financial resources), both in Italy and abroad; these funds are additional to the scholarship the amount of which is determined for each program for a total of 10% of the gross year amount of the agency, except for financial additions on the allotted operational funds within the administrative department of the program.

The Doctoral program scholarship is taxable for social security "INPS a gestione separata" as per art. 2, comma 26, of Law 8 August 1995, no.335 and subsequent modifications and integrations, in the following percentages: two-thirds in charge of the administration and one third of the student.

Scholarships funded by other universities or public entities can be limited to specific research areas. The scholarships which fall in this category will oblige the student to focus on these areas in compliance with the conditions foreseen in the agreement. The Board of Teachers will be tasked with verifying that these conditions are met.

For the Research Doctoral Programs established and activated in virtue of cooperation agreements with other prestigious and internationally renowned universities and foreign research entities as per art. 10 of D.M. 45/2013, the norms relating to the scholarships will be defined in the agreements.

The norms in the present Call are not applicable to foreign students or beneficiaries of financial aid in specific mobility programs for which there is specific regulation.

The scholarships for Doctoral Programs can not be utilized in conjunction with other scholarships granted for whatever reason, with the exception of those granted by national or foreign institutions for the purpose to complete the recipients' research and learning activity training in the programs.

Those who are recipient of a scholarship, even if only partially, to attend another doctoral program at any other Italian University cannot be granted another.

Art.8

Fees to access and attend the program

The doctoral students who are not recipients of either scholarships or doctoral research grants must pay fees in the amount established each year by the Administration Council after having received the Academic Senate's approval, as per the decree in the present call for the doctoral program – XXIX cycle.

The doctoral students who are recipients of a scholarship and have either lost the right to the scholarship or have renounced for whatever reason, will be exempt from fees.

The annual fee to attend the program is established on the bases of income as defined in D.R. no. 1966 del 6/11/2013, as follows:

The evaluation of the qualifications will regard university education, as well as any further educational and/or professional and research experience the candidate has gained and any scientific publications (you are advised to attach and/or declare all of the qualifications you have, complete with all elements that can help in evaluating them, including grades obtained within each educational course).

The evaluation will also regard the drafting of a research project by the candidate, to be developed during the three years of the course on one of the themes of the curricula the PhD is composed of, the draft of the research project must be presented with the application form to take part in the selection process.

To avoid the risk of not being evaluated the qualifications must be presented according to the conditions described in article 3 of the selection announcement ("Bando")

The interview will regard subject matter pertaining to the curricula the PhD is composed of and will also aim at verifying the candidate's aptitude towards research, his/her availability to spend research experience periods abroad as well as the scientific interests of the candidate. For this purpose, during the interview the candidate must be prepared to illustrate the research project he/she presented with the application form to participate in the selection for the purpose of the evaluation of qualifications. The interview must be held in Italian. There will also be verification of the knowledge of a foreign language that the candidate indicated on the application form, of one of the following languages: English, French, German, Spanish.

The minimum mark to pass the interview is **21/30**.

Eligibility is obtained with a total mark equal to or above 39/60
