



### **DOUBLE DEGREE "WORLD RELIGIONS AND PHILOSOPHY"**

# BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF PERUGIA (Master's Degree in "Philosophy and Ethics", Department of Philosophy, Social Sciences and Education of the University of Perugia) AND THE FU JEN CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY, TAIPEI ("Masters of Arts" of the Department of Religious Studies issued by Fu Jen Catholic University)

#### PURPOSES

The object of the present agreement is the implementation of a joint study program aimed at the attainment of a joint degree and, specifically, of a second level degree in "Philosophy and Ethics of Relations" (Class LM78) issued by the Department of Philosophy, Social Sciences and Education of the University of Perugia and of "Masters of Arts" of the Department of Religious Studies issued by Fu Jen Catholic University.

#### STUDENTS

Students participating in the program shall be exempted from payment of university tuition at the partner university. Students are responsible, however, for payment of all normal expenses arising from their study at the partner universities.

Students participating in the exchange shall have the same benefits and are at the same time subject to the rules and regulations of the institutions in which they carry out their study program. They may use all services offered by the host university to its own students

#### COORDINATOR

#### DIDACTIC

The exams successfully passed at the partner university will be automatically recognized by the student's home university.

When they arrive at the Fu Jen Catholic University (host university) students from the university of Perugia shall be regularly enrolled in the "Masters of Arts" Program of the Department of Religious Studies and shall complete a minimum of 12 Taiwanese credits (corresponding to 36 CFU/ECTS) and a maximum of 20 Taiwanese credits (corresponding to 60 CFU/ECTS). 1 Taiwanese credit corresponds to 3 CFU/ECTS.

The Fu Jen University shall offer at least <u>3 courses taught in English</u> and <u>1 compulsory foreign</u> <u>language course and/or trainship</u> (Chinese language for the students from Perugia University, and Italian language for the students from Fu Jen Catholic University), for a total amount of at least 36 CFU/ECTS / 12 Taiwanese credits; other courses shall be offered in the language of the host country.

Each student's study program will be a combination of the study programs of the two Departments involved (see below):
